AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR COLONOSCOPIES FOR COLON CANCER SURVIVORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 individual and group health insurance policies delivered, issued for
- 3 delivery, renewed, amended or continued in this state to provide full
- 4 coverage with no copayment for colonoscopies for survivors of colon
- 5 cancer.

Statement of Purpose:

To remove financial obstacles to post-cancer treatment screening for colon cancer survivors.
