AN ACT CONCERNING BILLING FOR ASSISTED LIVING SERVICES COVERED BY LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368bb of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 assisted living facilities and assisted living services agencies to directly
- 3 bill long-term care insurance companies for services provided to a
- 4 resident that are reimbursable under the resident's long-term care
- 5 insurance.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit direct billing of long-term care insurance companies for assisted living expenses and services that are covered under policies issued by such companies.
