**AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM AGE FOR OBTAINING A  
MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVER'S PERMIT OR OPERATOR'S LICENSE  
FROM SIXTEEN TO EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the minimum age for acquiring a driver's permit or license be
- 2 increased from sixteen to eighteen years of age.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To increase road safety and overall driver preparation.
