**AN ACT REQUIRING PERSONS CONVICTED OF DUI TO INSTALL
IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICES IN THEIR VEHICLES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that persons
- 2 convicted of DUI shall install, at their expense, an ignition interlock
- 3 device in their vehicle within ninety days following such conviction, or
- 4 shall forfeit such vehicle to the state; and that such device shall be
- 5 maintained in the vehicle for three years following the date of
- 6 conviction.

Statement of Purpose:

To require persons convicted of DUI to install ignition interlock devices in their vehicles.
