AN ACT REQUIRING THE IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE OF ANY PERSON UNDER TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE WHO IS CONVICTED FOR A FIRST OFFENSE OF DRUNK DRIVING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that any person
- 2 under the age of twenty-one, who is convicted for a first offense of
- 3 violating section 14-227a of the general statutes, shall have their license
- 4 suspended immediately until such time as the driver reaches age
- 5 twenty-one, or six months, whichever is longer.

Statement of Purpose:

To immediately suspend the driver's license of any person under twenty-one who drives drunk.
