AN ACT AUTHORIZING A BOY SCOUT "COFFEE STOP" ON I-95.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Boy Scout Troop 24 of East Lyme is
2 authorized to operate an annual coffee stop at the Waterford Weigh
3 Station on Interstate 95 during Labor Day weekend, in accordance with
4 any public health and safety standards or requirements that may be
5 established by the Division of State Police of the Department of Public
6 Safety, the Department of Motor Vehicles or the Department of
7 Transportation.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
