**AN ACT CONCERNING CONSISTENCY IN PERMITTING
REQUIREMENTS FOR ALTERNATIVE ON-SITE SEWAGE
TREATMENT SYSTEMS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner
2 of Environmental Protection to consider the factors established in
3 subsection (b) of section 19a-35a of the general statutes prior to (1)
4 issuing a permit for new discharge pursuant to section 22a-430 of the
5 general statutes, and (2) approving an engineering report pursuant to
6 section 7-247 of the general statutes, and to require a municipality to
7 consider the factors established in subsection (b) of section 19a-35a of
8 the general statutes prior to establishing a decentralized wastewater
9 management district by ordinance pursuant to section 7-247 of the
10 general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide consistency in the permitting of decentralized wastewater systems, alternative on-site sewage treatment systems and for new discharges.
