AN ACT CONCERNING REGISTRATION WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) (a) The Department of
2 Motor Vehicles shall not issue or renew any motor vehicle operator's
3 license or learner's permit pursuant to chapter 246 of the general
4 statutes and shall not issue or renew an identity card pursuant to
5 section 1-1h of the general statutes unless the applicant, at the time of
6 application, (1) registers with the federal Selective Service System,
7 established pursuant to the Military Selective Service Act, 50 USC App.
8 451 et seq., in the manner provided in the agreement entered into in
9 accordance with subsection (b) of this section, (2) establishes to the
10 satisfaction of the department that the applicant is registered with said
11 system, or (3) establishes that the applicant is exempt from registration
12 with said system. The department shall notify any applicant required
13 to register with the Selective Service System that, by applying for
14 issuance or renewal of an operator's license, permit or identity card,
15 the applicant consents to registration with said system.

16 (b) The department shall enter into an agreement with the Selective

17 Service System that provides for creation of forms by the department
18 sufficient for registration with said system and that authorizes the
19 department to forward such registration to said system, electronically,
20 in a form and manner sufficient for registration with said system.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	October 1, 2009	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To require state residents, when applying for a new or renewed operator's license or identity card, to register with the United States Selective Service System.
