**AN ACT CONCERNING EXEMPTION FROM FEES FOR MEMBERS OF  
THE ARMED FORCES CALLED TO ACTIVE SERVICE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 27-102a of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*  
3 *passage*):

4 (b) Any member of the armed forces of any state or of any reserve  
5 component of the armed forces of the United States who has been  
6 called to active service in the armed forces of any state or the armed  
7 forces of the United States shall be exempt from the payment of any  
8 fine or late fee assessed for failure to renew a motor vehicle operator's  
9 license or motor vehicle registration or for failure to have emissions  
10 inspection performed in a timely manner provided such member  
11 renews the license or registration or has the member's vehicle  
12 inspected at an official emissions inspection station no later than sixty  
13 days following the date such member is released from the qualifying  
14 military service.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
