AN ACT CONCERNING CANADIAN-AMERICAN DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 10-29a of the general statutes is
2 amended by adding subdivision (53) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

3 (NEW) (53) The Governor shall proclaim July first of each year to be
4 Canadian-American Day to honor Americans of Canadian ancestry,
5 their culture and the great contribution they have made to this
6 country. Suitable exercises shall be held in the State Capitol and
7 elsewhere as the Governor designates for the observance of the day.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
