**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS TANKS ON TRUCKS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than July 1, 2009,  
2 the Department of Public Safety shall, within available appropriations,  
3 conduct a study to determine whether existing federal or state  
4 regulation of commercial motor vehicles applies to any tank containing  
5 liquefied natural gas attached to such vehicle, and whether existing  
6 law sufficiently protects public safety. No later than August 3, 2009,  
7 the department shall submit a report, in accordance with the  
8 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, with the results of  
9 such study to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly  
10 having cognizance of matters relating to public safety.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

***Statement of Purpose:***

To require the Commissioner of Public Safety to conduct a study of whether existing law applies to, and sufficiently regulates, the carrying of liquefied natural gas tanks on trucks.
