AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEFINITION OF BIOTECHNOLOGY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (89) of subsection (a) of section 12-412 of the
2 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
3 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2009, and applicable to sales on and after January 1,*
4 *2009*):

5 (89) Sales of and the storage, use or other consumption of
6 machinery, equipment, tools, materials, supplies and fuel used directly
7 in the biotechnology industry. For the purposes of this subdivision,
8 "biotechnology" means (A) the application of technologies, such as
9 recombinant DNA techniques, biochemistry, molecular and cellular
10 biology, genetics and genetic engineering, biological cell fusion
11 techniques, and new bioprocesses, using living organisms, or parts of
12 organisms, to produce or modify products, to improve plants or
13 animals, to identify targets for small molecule pharmaceutical
14 development, to transform biological systems into useful processes
15 and products or to develop microorganisms for specific uses, or (B)
16 any instrument, apparatus, appliance, material or other article,
17 whether used alone or in combination, intended by the manufacturer

18 to be used for the purpose of diagnosis, prevention, monitoring,
19 treatment or alleviation of disease or investigation, replacement or
20 modification of the anatomy or of a physiological process.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
