AN ACT CONCERNING FINGERPRINTING METHODS USED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Motor
2 Vehicles shall take immediate steps to provide electronic
3 fingerprinting services to any applicant for a license or endorsement
4 pursuant to section 14-44 of the general statutes who is required to
5 submit fingerprints in order to receive such license or endorsement.
6 After the department has taken such fingerprints and submitted them,
7 electronically, to the appropriate law enforcement agency, the
8 department shall proceed with any other license or endorsement
9 requirements while awaiting the results of such fingerprinting.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
