AN ACT MAXIMIZING THE FEDERAL STIMULUS FUNDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2009*) Not later than January 1,
2 2010, and quarterly thereafter, the Commissioner of Social Services, in
3 consultation with the Secretary of the Office of Policy and
4 Management, shall: (1) Submit an accounting, in accordance with the
5 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing
6 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
7 relating to human services and appropriations specifically identifying
8 the expenditure of federal stimulus funds provided to the state for
9 programs administered by the Department of Social Services; and (2)
10 submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of
11 the general statutes, to the joint standing committees of the General
12 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to human services and
13 appropriations recommending ways for the state to maximize federal
14 stimulus funds for the benefit of federally qualified health centers so
15 that individuals who lack health insurance may receive quality health
16 care.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
