AN ACT CONCERNING GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The joint standing committee of the
2 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to elections
3 shall conduct a study of the functions of state agencies and any
4 functional overlaps or other redundancies among state agencies to
5 promote efficiency and, not later than January 1, 2010, shall submit a
6 report to the General Assembly on its findings and recommendations.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
