AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES OF THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT, THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE, THE PUBLIC DEFENDER SERVICES COMMISSION AND THE STATE MARSHAL COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2009*) The Chief Court Administrator shall
2 review the functions and activities of the Judicial Department in order
3 to assign priority for the continued funding of such functions and
4 activities and shall submit, in accordance with section 11-4a of the
5 general statutes, findings, including any recommendation for
6 legislation to modify such functions and activities, to the joint standing
7 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
8 relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not later
9 than January 1, 2010.

10 Sec. 2 (*Effective July 1, 2009*) The Chief State's Attorney shall review
11 the functions and activities of the Division of Criminal Justice in order
12 to assign priority for the continued funding of such functions and
13 activities and shall submit, in accordance with section 11-4a of the
14 general statutes, findings, including any recommendation for

15 legislation to modify such functions and activities, to the joint standing
 16 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
 17 relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not later
 18 than January 1, 2010.

19 Sec. 3 (*Effective July 1, 2009*) The Chief Public Defender shall review
 20 the functions and activities of the Public Defender Services
 21 Commission in order to assign priority for the continued funding of
 22 such functions and activities and shall submit, in accordance with
 23 section 11-4a of the general statutes, findings, including any
 24 recommendation for legislation to modify such functions and
 25 activities, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
 26 having cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the
 27 budgets of state agencies not later than January 1, 2010.

28 Sec. 4. (*Effective July 1, 2009*) The chairperson of the State Marshal
 29 Commission shall review the activities of the commission in order to
 30 assign priority for the continued funding of such activities and shall
 31 submit, in accordance with section 11-4a of the general statutes,
 32 findings, including any recommendation for legislation to modify such
 33 activities, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
 34 having cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the
 35 budgets of state agencies not later than January 1, 2010.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
