



Substitute House Bill No. 6193

Public Act No. 09-6

AN ACT CONCERNING THE LEGISLATIVE COMMISSIONERS' RECOMMENDATIONS FOR TECHNICAL REVISIONS TO THE LABOR STATUTES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Subdivision (5) of subsection (a) of section 31-221c of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

(5) A statement of ownership [] that includes the name and evidence of the business experience of any person that, individually or acting in concert with one or more other persons, owns or controls or will control, directly or indirectly, twenty-five per cent or more of the equity interest of the applicant.

Sec. 2. Subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of section 31-221c of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

(b) (1) Each professional employer organization operating within this state on January 1, 2009, shall submit its initial registration not later than March 1, 2009. Such initial registration shall be valid until one hundred eighty days after the professional employer organization's first completed fiscal year that is more than one year

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after March 1, 2009. Each professional employer organization or professional employer organization group shall file with the commissioner the beginning and ending date of each professional employer [organization] organization's or professional employer organization group's fiscal year and notify and file with the commissioner any change to the beginning and ending date of such fiscal year.

Sec. 3. Subdivision (3) of subsection (e) of section 31-221c of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

(3) If a professional employer organization or professional employer organization group seeks to file a limited registration with the commissioner, the professional employer organization or professional employer organization group shall provide the commissioner with sufficient information and documentation that the professional employer organization or professional employer organization group qualifies for a limited registration.

Sec. 4. Subsection (i) of section 31-221c of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

(i) The applicant or registrant shall notify the commissioner of any change of address for any location, as described in subsection (h) of this section, no later than five working days after such change.

Sec. 5. Subdivision (4) of subsection (j) of section 31-225a of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

(4) Commencing with the first calendar quarter of 2009, each employer subject to this chapter who makes contributions or payments in lieu of contributions for two hundred fifty or more employees

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receiving wages in employment subject to this chapter, and each person or organization that, as an agent, makes contributions or payments in lieu of contributions for a total of two hundred fifty or more employees receiving wages in employment subject to this chapter on behalf of one or more employers subject to this chapter shall make such [contribution or payment] contributions or payments in lieu of contributions electronically.
