



**Senate Bill No. 1167**

**Public Act No. 09-111**

**AN ACT CONCERNING A STATE DEFICIT MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2009.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The amounts appropriated to the following agencies in section 11 of public act 07-1 of the June special session, as amended by section 68 of public act 07-5 of the June special session, section 3 of public act 08-1 of the November 24 special session, section 4 of public act 09-1 and section 1 of public act 09-2, are reduced by the following amounts for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009:

Sec. 2. (Effective from passage) (a) The sum of \$6,000,000, exclusive of assessments, shall be transferred from the Banking Fund, established under section 36a-65 of the general statutes, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

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(b) The sum of \$6,492,122 shall be transferred from the resources of the Special Transportation Fund and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraph (A) of subdivision (2) of subsection (c) of section 4-28e of the general statutes, the sum of \$5,000,000 shall be transferred from the Tobacco and Health Trust Fund and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(d) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 19a-73b of the general statutes, the sum of \$1,000,000 shall be transferred from the Connecticut Cancer Partnership Account and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(e) The sum of \$81,596 shall be transferred from the Insurance Recoveries account, Military Department, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(f) The sum of \$2,200,000 shall be transferred from the OPEB Teachers' Fund and credited to the Retirees Health Service Cost account, within the Teachers' Retirement Board, in the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

Sec. 3. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes:

(1) The sum of \$600,000 shall be transferred from the Sales and Services Business Enterprise Program account, Board of Education and Services for the Blind, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(2) The sum of \$5,972 shall be transferred from the Birth-to-Three Service Coordination account, Board of Education and Services for the Blind, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal

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year ending June 30, 2009.

(3) The sum of \$900,000 shall be transferred from the CT Health and Educational Facilities account, Connecticut Health and Educational Facilities Authority, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(4) The sum of \$1,414,874 shall be transferred from the Dog Licenses account, Department of Agriculture, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(5) The sum of \$40,104 shall be transferred from the Agriculture Exposition account, Department of Agriculture, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(6) The sum of \$534,811 shall be transferred from the Animal Population Control account, Department of Agriculture, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(7) The sum of \$18,285 shall be transferred from the Connecticut Creative Store account, Department of Agriculture, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(8) The sum of \$13,941 shall be transferred from the Connecticut Grown Food account, Department of Agriculture, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(9) The sum of \$15,000 shall be transferred from the invasive species detection and control account, Department of Agriculture, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(10) The sum of \$120,000 shall be transferred from the Conference and Seminars account, Department of Administrative Services, and

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credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(11) The sum of \$110,000 shall be transferred from the Wilderness School Program account, Department of Children and Families, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(12) The sum of \$50,000 shall be transferred from the drug assets forfeiture revolving account, Division of Criminal Justice, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(13) The sum of \$10,465 shall be transferred from the Seized Assets to Support Undercover Operations account, Division of Criminal Justice, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(14) The sum of \$43,000 shall be transferred from the Connecticut Itinerant Vendors Guaranty Fund, Department of Consumer Protection, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(15) The sum of \$280,000 shall be transferred from the Bedding and Filling Material account, Department of Consumer Protection, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(16) The sum of \$500,000 shall be transferred from the new automobile warranties account, Department of Consumer Protection, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(17) The sum of \$7,028 shall be transferred from the Self-Determinations Conference account, Department of Developmental

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Services, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(24) The sum of \$16,700,000 shall be transferred from the Environmental Quality Fund, Department of Environmental

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Protection, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(25) The sum of \$9,900,000 shall be transferred from the Conservation Fund, Department of Environmental Protection, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(26) The sum of \$524,799 shall be transferred from the Bird Mitigation Survey Project account, Department of Environmental Protection, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(27) The sum of \$6,982 shall be transferred from the Wetlands Restoration, Projection account, Department of Environmental Protection, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(28) The sum of \$71,858 shall be transferred from the Soil Conservation Equipment account, Department of Environmental Protection, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(29) The sum of \$23,494 shall be transferred from the forest fire-fighting equipment account, Department of Environmental Protection, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(30) The sum of \$16,900,000 shall be transferred from the Clean Air Act account, Department of Environmental Protection, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(31) The sum of \$10,138 shall be transferred from the Digital Map Generation account, Department of Environmental Protection, and

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credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(32) The sum of \$713,831 shall be transferred from the Recreation and Natural Heritage Program account, Department of Environmental Protection, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(33) The sum of \$579,871 shall be transferred from the Academic Scholars Program (ELEET), Department of Higher Education, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(34) The sum of \$600,000 shall be transferred from the private occupational school student protection account, Department of Higher Education, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(35) The sum of \$5,329 shall be transferred from the General Education account, Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(36) The sum of \$346,135 shall be transferred from the drug assets forfeiture revolving account, Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(37) The sum of \$805,114 shall be transferred from the Community Mental Health Strategic Investment account, Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(38) The sum of \$200,000 shall be transferred from the chronic gamblers treatment and rehabilitation account, Department of Mental

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Health and Addiction Services, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(39) The sum of \$20,000 shall be transferred from the Psychological, Psychosexual Evaluation account, Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(40) The sum of \$200,000 shall be transferred from the CT Recovery Purchase Project Phase 2 account, Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(41) The sum of \$2,960 shall be transferred from the PACCT account, Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(42) The sum of \$245,000 shall be transferred from the Investor Education Fund, Banking Department, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(43) The sum of \$1,200,000 shall be transferred from the Correction Industries account, Department of Correction, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(44) The sum of \$1,613,133 shall be transferred from the Correction Commissaries account, Department of Correction, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(45) The sum of \$37,750 shall be transferred from the Sale of Enfield Property account, Department of Correction, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(46) The sum of \$2,672,368 shall be transferred from the Correctional

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General Welfare Fund, Department of Correction, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(47) The sum of \$97,802 shall be transferred from the Culinary Arts Program account, Department of Correction, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(61) The sum of \$100,000 shall be transferred from the Pistol Permits Photographic Costs account, Department of Public Safety, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30,

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2009.

(62) The sum of \$250,000 shall be transferred from the Court Reimbursements account, Department of Public Safety, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(63) The sum of \$37,000 shall be transferred from the Fire Safety Standard Act account, Department of Public Safety, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(64) The sum of \$800,000 shall be transferred from the Siting Council account, Department of Public Utility Control, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(65) The sum of \$1,900,000 shall be transferred from the public, educational and governmental programming and education technology investment account, Department of Public Utility Control, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(66) The sum of \$35,274 shall be transferred from the Conference Fees account, Department of Social Services, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(67) The sum of \$65,667 shall be transferred from the Support System for Early Care Project account, Department of Social Services, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(68) The sum of \$200,000 shall be transferred from the brain injury prevention and services account, Department of Social Services, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

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(69) The sum of \$75,000 shall be transferred from the Fire School Training and Educational Extension account, Commission on Fire Prevention and Control, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(70) The sum of \$25,000 shall be transferred from the state fire school auxiliary services account, Commission on Fire Prevention and Control, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(71) The sum of \$1,100,000 shall be transferred from the Judicial Data Processing Operations Revolving Fund, Judicial Department, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(72) The sum of \$875,000 shall be transferred from the Meriden Courthouse Maintenance Reserve account, Judicial Department, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(73) The sum of \$550,000 shall be transferred from the Derby Courthouse Maintenance Reserve account, Judicial Department, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(74) The sum of \$354,685 shall be transferred from the Community Service Labor program, Judicial Department, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(75) The sum of \$246,716 shall be transferred from the Law Library - Donated Copier Receipts account, Judicial Department, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(76) The sum of \$7,485 shall be transferred from the Inaugural Ball

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account, Military Department, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(77) The sum of \$18,000 shall be transferred from the Child Poverty and Prevention Council account, Legislative Management, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(78) The sum of \$10,230 shall be transferred from the Regional Energy Conference account, Office of Policy and Management, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(79) The sum of \$175,000 shall be transferred from the Long Term Care Insurance Study account, Office of Policy and Management, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(80) The sum of \$668,963 shall be transferred from the Low-Level Radioactive Waste Management account, Office of Policy and Management, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(81) The sum of \$1,000,000 shall be transferred from the Energy Advisory Board Conferences account, Office of Policy and Management, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(82) The sum of \$10,642 shall be transferred from the Local Emergency Relief account, Office of Policy and Management, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(83) The sum of \$19,000 shall be transferred from the Disposition of Surplus State Property account, Office of Policy and Management, and

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credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(84) The sum of \$309,893 shall be transferred from the CMIA Settlements account, State Comptroller, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(85) The sum of \$7,500,000 shall be transferred from the Debt Retirement Fund SCRF account, State Treasurer, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(86) The sum of \$9,045,535 shall be transferred from the Rental Housing Fund, State Treasurer, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(87) Upon approval of the State Bond commission prior to June 30, 2009, the sum of \$4,964,477 shall be transferred from the GO Bonds for Transportation Bond Fund 13004, State Treasurer, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(88) The sum of \$175,000 shall be transferred from the Vocational Education Instruction account, Department of Education, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(89) The sum of \$1,500,000 shall be transferred from the Commercial Recording Administration account, Secretary of the State, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(90) The sum of \$900,000 shall be transferred from the historic documents preservation account, State Library, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(91) The sum of \$34,894 shall be transferred from the Workers'

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Compensation Seminars account, Workers' Compensation Commission, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(92) The sum of \$700,000 shall be transferred from the Citizens' Election Fund administration account, Elections Enforcement Commission, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

(93) The sum of \$650,000 shall be transferred from the dry cleaning establishment remediation administrative account, Department of Economic and Community Development, and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

Sec. 4. Section 3-21c of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

Notwithstanding any general statute, public act or special act, upon a determination by the Treasurer and approval by the State Bond Commission that unexpended proceeds of transportation related general obligation bonds of the state issued pursuant to section 3-20 and accounted for in a general obligation bond fund of the state established by the Treasurer are no longer required for any of the purposes or projects funded or remaining to be funded from amounts in such bond fund, the Treasurer is authorized to transfer all or any portion of said unexpended bond proceeds from such bond fund for further credit to (1) the Special Transportation Fund of the state established pursuant to section 13b-68, provided the debt service on the bonds from which such unexpended proceeds were derived is otherwise payable from the Special Transportation Fund as permitted by section 13b-69, [and provided further] or (2) the General Fund. For transfers to either fund, the Treasurer shall determine that such transfer shall not adversely affect the exclusion from gross income of the interest on the bonds from which such unexpended proceeds are

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derived, pursuant to Section 103 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or any corresponding internal revenue code of the United States, as from time to time amended.

Sec. 5. Section 3-17a of the general statutes is repealed. (*Effective from passage*)
