"AN ACT CONCERNING DEFICIT MITIGATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2009."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions
4 of section 2-8 of the general statutes, for the fiscal years ending June 30,
5 2009, to June 30, 2011, inclusive, the members and officers of the
6 General Assembly shall receive salaries that are ten per cent less than
7 the salaries specified in said section.

8 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 3-2 of the general
9 statutes, for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2009, to June 30, 2011,
10 inclusive, the Governor and the Lieutenant Governor shall receive
11 salaries that are ten per cent less than the salaries specified in said
12 section.

13 (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 3-11 of the general

14 statutes, for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2009, to June 30, 2011,
15 inclusive, the Treasurer shall receive a salary that is ten per cent less
16 than the salary specified in said section.

17 (d) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 3-77 of the general
18 statutes, for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2009, to June 30, 2011,
19 inclusive, the Secretary of the State shall receive a salary that is ten per
20 cent less than the salary specified in said section.

21 (e) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 3-111 of the general
22 statutes, for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2009, to June 30, 2011,
23 inclusive, the Comptroller shall receive a salary that is ten per cent less
24 than the salary specified in said section.

25 (f) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 3-124 of the general
26 statutes, for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2009, to June 30, 2011,
27 inclusive, the Attorney General shall receive a salary that is ten per
28 cent less than the salary specified in said section.

29 (g) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2009, to June 30, 2011,
30 inclusive, the commissioners of state agencies and the executive
31 directors of boards and commissions shall receive salaries in amounts
32 that are ten per cent less than the amounts of the salaries they received
33 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008.

34 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions
35 of section 2-15 of the general statutes, no member of the General
36 Assembly shall receive any transportation allowance.

37 (b) No member of the General Assembly or legislative employee
38 shall receive payment from the state for any expenses associated with
39 or resulting from attendance at any conference or other meeting in this
40 state or another state or for any other travel related expense.

41 Sec. 503. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
42 section 2-15a of the general statutes, no member of the General
43 Assembly shall be entitled to any unsolicited mailings at the expense

44 of the state."
