**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE AWARD OF RIBBONS AND MEDALS
TO VETERANS FOR SERVICE IN TIME OF WAR."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 3-2b of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

5 The Commissioner of Veterans' Affairs shall cause to be erected at
6 the grave of any person who has served as Governor, Lieutenant
7 Governor, Secretary of the State, Treasurer, Comptroller, Attorney
8 General or member of the General Assembly of this state and who died
9 or dies subsequent to January 1, 1971, a footstone, marked with the
10 seal of the state, the name of the deceased, the date of his death and the
11 office or offices in which he served and the dates such service was
12 rendered. The commissioner shall also provide for such grave a flag
13 holder and a Connecticut state flag. At the request of the next of kin of

14 any such [officer or member of the General Assembly] Governor,
15 Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of the State, Treasurer, Comptroller or
16 Attorney General, the Commissioner of Public Safety shall provide an
17 honor guard of six state policemen to attend the funeral and burial of
18 such officer. [or member.] At the request of the next of kin of any such
19 member of the General Assembly, the executive director of the Joint
20 Committee on Legislative Management shall direct the chief of police
21 of the Office of State Capitol Police to provide an honor guard of State
22 Capitol police officers to attend the funeral and burial of such
23 member."
