**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PAYMENT OF PERSONAL SERVICE  
AND PURCHASE OF SERVICE CONTRACTS."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding any  
4 provision of the general statutes, within available appropriations, for  
5 each personal service contract and purchase of service contract entered  
6 into by the state, including, but not limited to, personal service  
7 contracts and purchase of service contracts for the provision of health  
8 and human services: (1) Once any such contract is issued by the state  
9 contracting agency, signed by the contractor and returned to such state  
10 contracting agency, such contract shall be rejected or approved by such  
11 state contracting agency and, if approved, submitted to the Attorney  
12 General for review, not later than thirty days after such contract is  
13 received by the state contracting agency; (2) the Attorney General shall  
14 approve or reject such contract not later than twenty-one days after

15 receipt of such contract from the state contracting agency for review;  
16 and (3) not later than forty-five days after receipt by the state  
17 contracting agency of a written request for payment from the  
18 contractor or the expiration of a contractual deadline for payment, the  
19 state contracting agency shall either submit such payment to the  
20 contractor or notify the contractor of its refusal to pay, in whole or in  
21 part, any such amount, and the basis for such refusal."
