"AN ACT CONCERNING THE LEGISLATIVE COMMISSIONERS' RECOMMENDATIONS FOR TECHNICAL REVISIONS TO THE HUMAN SERVICES STATUTES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 17b-112e of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
5 *1, 2009*):

6 (a) The Department of Social Services shall provide safety net
7 services for certain families identified as having significant barriers to
8 employment and families who are at risk of losing benefits under the
9 temporary family assistance program or no longer receiving program
10 benefits. [Such] To be eligible for safety net services, such families
11 shall; [include those:] (1) [Identified] Have been identified as having
12 significant barriers to employment during the initial assessment by the
13 department's eligibility worker or during the first twelve months of

14 employment services by an employment services case manager; (2)
15 [who] have made a good faith effort to seek and maintain employment
16 but have not been able to do so or [who are] be at risk of failing to
17 complete the employment services program; (3) [who] have exhausted
18 their eligibility for temporary family assistance program benefits; [and]
19 or (4) [who are] not be eligible for six-month extensions of temporary
20 family assistance benefits due to: (A) The receipt of two sanctions from
21 the department during the first twenty months of the twenty-one-
22 month time limit of said temporary family assistance program; or (B)
23 the determination by the department that such a family has not made a
24 good-faith effort to seek and maintain employment."
