"AN ACT CONCERNING GREEN CLEANING PRODUCTS IN SCHOOLS."

1 Strike subsection (d) of section 1 in its entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(d) On or before October 1, 2010, and annually thereafter, each local
4 and regional board of education shall provide the staff of each school
5 and, upon request, the parents and guardians of each child enrolled in
6 each school with a written statement of the school district's green
7 cleaning program. Such notice shall include (1) the types and names of
8 environmentally preferable cleaning products being applied in schools,
9 (2) the location of the application of such cleaning products in the
10 school buildings and facilities, (3) the schedule of when such cleaning
11 products are applied in the school buildings and facilities, (4) the
12 statement, "No parent, guardian, teacher or staff member may bring
13 into the school facility any consumer product which is intended to

14 clean, deodorize, sanitize or disinfect.", and (5) the name of the school
15 administrator, or a designee, who may be contacted for further
16 information. Such notice shall be provided to the parents or guardians
17 of any child who transfers to a school during the school year and to
18 staff hired during the school year. Each local or regional board of
19 education shall make such notice, as well as the report submitted to the
20 Department of Education pursuant to subsection (a) of section 10-220
21 of the general statutes, as amended by this act, available on its web site
22 and the web site of each school under such board's jurisdiction. If no
23 such web site exists, the board shall make such notice otherwise
24 publicly available."
