"AN ACT CONCERNING BANNING BISPHENOL-A IN CHILDREN'S PRODUCTS AND FOOD PRODUCTS AND PROHIBITING CERTAIN ALTERNATIVE SUBSTANCES."

1 Strike section 1 in its entirety and renumber the remaining sections
2 and internal references accordingly:

3 In line 26, after "bisphenol-A" insert ", provided a safe alternative is
4 available, as determined by the Commissioner of Consumer Protection
5 in any regulations adopted pursuant to section 501 of this act."

6 In line 39, after "bisphenol-A" insert ", provided a safe alternative is
7 available, as determined by the Commissioner of Consumer Protection
8 in any regulations adopted pursuant to section 501 of this act."

9 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
10 internal references accordingly:

11 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2010*) The Commissioner of

12 Consumer Protection may, in consultation with the Commissioner of
13 Public Health, adopt regulations, in accordance with the provisions of
14 chapter 54 of the general statutes, to determine if there exist any safe
15 alternative to using bisphenol-A in reusable food or beverage
16 containers as defined in section 2 of this act and in containers, jars or
17 cans containing infant formula and baby food, as such terms are
18 defined in section 3 of this act."
