"AN ACT PERMITTING THE IMPORTATION OF REINDEER."

- 1 Change the effective date of section 1 to "Effective July 1, 2009"
- 2 In line 4, after "provided" insert "(1)"
- 3 In line 6, after "period" insert ", and (2) such importation complies
- 4 with the following requirements: Each reindeer so imported (A) is
- 5 individually identified by a permanent metal ear tag, legible tattoo or
- 6 microchip, (B) possesses a certified veterinary report of inspection
- 7 documenting an inspection that occurred at least one day and not
- 8 more than thirty days prior to entry into the state, (C) possesses
- 9 documentation that verifies such reindeer (i) comes from a herd that is
- 10 free of both tuberculosis and brucellosis, or (ii) tested negative for
- 11 tuberculosis and brucellosis at least one day and not more than thirty
- 12 days prior to entry into the state, and (D) possesses documentation
- 13 that the originating herd participated in a state chronic wasting disease

14 monitoring program (i) not less than the prior three years if from a
15 state or province not known to have chronic wasting disease, or (ii) not
16 less than the prior five years if from a state or province known to have
17 chronic wasting disease outbreaks."
