**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) (a) Each person who  
4 purchases goods from someone who is not regularly engaged in the  
5 business of dealing in such goods and resells such goods via the  
6 Internet as a business shall maintain a record-keeping system which  
7 shall be entered in English, at the time he or she receives any such  
8 goods. Such record-keeping system shall include: (1) A description of  
9 such goods, (2) the name and residence or business address of the  
10 person from whom such goods were received, and (3) the year, day  
11 and hour when such goods were received. Such record-keeping  
12 system, place where such business is carried on and such physical  
13 location open to the public and all such goods therein may be  
14 examined at all times by any state police officer or by any municipal  
15 police officer from the municipality where such business is carried on

16 or where such physical location open to the public is situated. Any  
17 such state police officer or municipal police officer who performs such  
18 an examination may require any person on the premises to provide  
19 proof of his or her identity.

20 (b) Any person who wilfully violates any provision of subsection (a)  
21 of this section shall, for a first violation, have committed an infraction  
22 and, for a second or subsequent violation committed within two years  
23 of a prior violation, be guilty of a class A misdemeanor."
