"AN ACT CONCERNING GREEN JOBS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Department of
4 Economic and Community Development shall apply for federal
5 economic stimulus funds available pursuant to the American Recovery
6 and Reinvestment Act of 2009, P.L. 111-5, and establish with such
7 funds a program to create green jobs and promote green energy and
8 conservation by (1) targeting investments in renewable energy
9 research, development and deployment, and (2) promoting the use of
10 renewable energy in state buildings, nonprofits and educational
11 institutions. Such program shall include, but not be limited to,
12 components that emphasize the use of existing industries in the state
13 and that examine the viability of other renewable industries. Upon the

14 depletion of any such available federal economic stimulus funds, such
15 program shall terminate.

16 (b) On or before October 1, 2009, the Department of Economic and
17 Community Development shall report, in accordance with the
18 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing
19 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
20 relating to commerce regarding the status of the application for
21 funding and the implementation of the program, if established,
22 pursuant to subsection (a) of this section."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
