**"AN ACT ESTABLISHING A BI-STATE LONG ISLAND SOUND COMMISSION."**

1 Strike subsection (b) of section 1 in its entirety and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(b) There is established a Bi-State Long Island Sound Commission  
4 which shall consist of the Governors of the states of Connecticut and  
5 New York, or their designees, and in addition, seven members who are  
6 residents of Connecticut and seven members who are residents of New  
7 York. The seven Connecticut members shall be appointed to two-year  
8 terms as follows: (1) One appointed by the Governor, (2) one  
9 appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate, (3) one  
10 appointed by the majority leader of the Senate, (4) one appointed by  
11 the minority leader of the Senate, (5) one appointed by the speaker of  
12 the House of Representatives, (6) one appointed by the majority leader

13 of the House of Representatives, and (7) one appointed by the minority  
14 leader of the House of Representatives. The Governors of the states of  
15 Connecticut and New York, or their designees, shall serve as  
16 cochairpersons of said commission, ex-officio, unless the commission  
17 members select other chairpersons by majority vote. In no event shall  
18 the cochairpersons be from the same state."
