**"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE PROVISIONS OF THE BUDGET CONCERNING EDUCATION, AUTHORIZING STATE GRANT COMMITMENTS FOR SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECTS, AND MAKING CHANGES TO THE STATUTES CONCERNING SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECTS AND OTHER EDUCATION STATUTES."**

1 Strike section 48 in its entirety and renumber the sections  
2 accordingly

3 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
4 internal references accordingly:

5 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 10-145 of the general statutes, as  
6 amended by section 15 of public act 09-1 of the June 19 special session,  
7 is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
8 *from passage*):

9 (a) No teacher, supervisor, administrator, special service staff  
10 member or school superintendent, except as provided for in section 10-  
11 157, shall be employed in any of the schools of any local or regional

12 board of education unless such person possesses an appropriate state  
13 certificate, nor shall any such person be entitled to any salary unless  
14 such person can produce such certificate dated previous to or the first  
15 day of employment, except as provided for in section 10-157; provided  
16 nothing herein contained shall be construed to prevent the board of  
17 education from prescribing qualifications additional to those  
18 prescribed by the regulations of the State Board of Education and  
19 provided nothing herein contained shall be construed to prevent any  
20 local or regional board of education from contracting with a licensed  
21 drivers' school approved by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles for  
22 the behind-the-wheel instruction of a driver instruction course, to be  
23 given by driving instructors licensed by the Department of Motor  
24 Vehicles. No person shall be employed in any of the schools of any  
25 local or regional board of education as a substitute teacher unless such  
26 person holds a bachelor's degree, except that for those towns with a  
27 population of less than thirty thousand, or in the case of a regional  
28 school district, the Commissioner of Education may waive such  
29 requirement for good cause upon the request of a superintendent of  
30 schools."
