SUBJECT: Home Care Service Fee Schedule Update

In accordance with Section 17b-343 of Connecticut General Statutes and the budget for SFY 2010 (Sec. 77, Bill 7005), fees for Adult Day Health services are increased by 4.2% effective July 1, 2009. The fees for all other home care services remain unchanged for the SFY 2010 period:
