**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING PRIVATE AND MUNICIPAL RECYCLING, ZONING ORDINANCES, SOLID WASTE COLLECTION CONTRACTS AND SCHOOL RECYCLING PROGRAMS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To permit the Commissioner of Environmental Protection to issue a beneficial use permit for activities already permitted in neighboring states without extensive investigation, to relieve municipalities from the requirement of reporting the amount of recyclable items processed for recycling, to require certain plastic containers and chipboard to be recycled, to require commercial solid waste collection contracts to specify how recyclable items will be handled, to create a no-interest loan program for municipal recycling efforts, to create a grant program for municipalities to purchase recycling receptacles, to prohibit zoning ordinances from restricting the amount of space permitted for the storage of recyclables, and to permit the commissioner to contract with municipalities or third parties to enforce violations of the recycling requirements.
