**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING COMPETENCY TO STAND TRIAL.

**Statement of Purpose:** To amend procedures concerning the determination of a defendant's competency to stand trial by (1) providing examiners with access to the defendant's treatment history contained in the Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services' database, (2) providing that the examination be completed within fifteen business days, rather than fifteen calendar days, for consistency with the reporting deadline and to allow adequate time for such examination, and (3) require examiners to provide information obtained during the examination to the identified health care provider, and require treatment progress reports to be provided to the examiners.
