Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE COMMISSION ON CHILD PROTECTION AND THE CHIEF CHILD PROTECTION ATTORNEY.

Statement of Purpose: To: (1) Limit the number of transcripts the Commission on Child Protection is required to pay for in an appeal, (2) provide that mandated reporters who are hired by certain child protection attorneys comply with attorney-client privilege standards, (3) provide independent legal counsel for any child who is alleged to be neglected or uncared for or subject to a termination of parental rights petition, and (4) make a conforming change to clarify the Chief Child Protection Attorney's ability to contract with private law firms.
