**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING BANNING BISPHENOL-A IN CHILDREN'S PRODUCTS AND FOOD PRODUCTS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To ban any children's products containing bisphenol-A marketed for the use of children under the age of three years, to prohibit the replacement of the use of bisphenol-A with certain carcinogenic substances, to ban any reusable food containers or jars or cans containing food or

beverage products that contain bisphenol-A, and to require the labeling of certain products containing bisphenol-A.
