Title: AN ACT CONCERNING CREDIT FOR MILITARY TRAINING AND HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMAS FOR VETERANS.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) conduct a study to determine the effectiveness of a program that would exempt members of the National Guard from meeting certain professional training requirements for licenses or certification, and (2) allow a board of education to award a high school diploma to a veteran of the Korean Conflict or the Vietnam Era who left high school prior to graduation in order to serve in the armed forces.
