Title: AN ACT CONCERNING VICTIM COMPENSATION.

Statement of Purpose: To allow victim compensation to be awarded to state residents for crimes that occur outside the United States in countries that do not have a crime victim compensation program and increase the funding available for victim compensation by providing that moneys in the Criminal Injuries Compensation Fund may be expended for any of the statutory purposes of the fund, and are not subject to appropriation.
