**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING FORECLOSURE PROCEDURES.

**Statement of Purpose:** To clarify that notice of the availability of foreclosure mediation must be provided on the face of a writ, summons and complaint; and to allow judgments of strict foreclosure to be re-opened, by agreement of all appearing parties, for a period of up to four months after judgment has entered.
