**Title:** AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS TO INFORM MEDICAID BENEFICIARIES CONCERNING THE USE OF MEDICATIONS FOR THE TREATMENT OF OPIOID DEPENDENCY.

**Statement of Purpose:** To provide Medicaid-eligible patients receiving medication-assisted treatment for opioid addiction with the right to be informed of and treated with those medications that have been determined, according to the Drug Enforcement Agency's controlled substance schedule, to have a lesser potential to create or enhance dependency.
