Title: AN ACT EXPANDING THE BEVERAGE CONTAINER REDEMPTION PROVISIONS TO INCLUDE WATER BOTTLES.

Statement of Purpose: To expand the beverage container redemption provisions to include water bottles, to raise the refund value of beverage containers to ten cents, to require dealers to provide certain information to distributors, to require redemption centers established or significantly expanded on or after October 1, 2009, to locate such center near the main entrance of the business, and to raise the handling fee for redemption centers to three cents for all beverage containers.
