Title: AN ACT CONCERNING MUTUAL AID OR MOBILE SUPPORT UNITS AND NUCLEAR SAFETY EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM PLANS.

Statement of Purpose: To delete the requirement for state reimbursement for certain municipal emergency duty training costs, to clarify that compensation for emergency personnel only applies when such personnel are engaged in officially authorized civil preparedness duty under this section, and to change the submittal and approval dates for nuclear safety emergency preparedness program plans for consistency with the municipal budgetary cycle.
