**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN ELECTION PROCEDURES RELATING TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING.

**Statement of Purpose:** To accelerate the time within which municipal election officials are required to report election returns, shorten the deadline for recanvass returns, change the format of allowable street maps showing voter district lines, allow the Secretary of the State to impose a fine on town clerks who send maps in late, and adopt the 1992 procedures used to change state and local rules needed because of redistricting for changes needed in 2012.
