Title: AN ACT CONCERNING INDIVIDUAL AUTHORIZATIONS FOR BENEFICIAL USE OF SOLID WASTE.

Statement of Purpose: To give the Department of Environmental Protection the authority to issue individual beneficial determinations rather than the general permit authorized under current law, to require separate containers for the collection of recyclable items, to require that anyone contracting for solid waste collection also arrange for the collection of recyclable items, and to prohibit property owners from dumping on their own property.
