**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING INTERRUPTION OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE, SCRAP METAL PROCESSORS AND MOTOR VEHICLE RECYCLERS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To provide an enhanced penalty when the theft of telecommunications equipment interrupts emergency telecommunications services, impose certain requirements on scrap metal processors when they receive scrap equipment, wire or cable that could be used in the transmission or distribution of electricity and provide penalties for persons and entities that advertise or hold themselves out as motor vehicle recyclers but are not licensed.
