Dear Panel on DCF:

1. Question: Why does DCF label parents (Fathers) who call the hot line to report abuse or when a Father reports a child's mother for physical abuse of their child a "perpetrator"?
2. Question: Why did a DCF worker from the Meriden Office kick in my apartment door to my apartment to allow my estranged wife to come in and remove my personal property, which I have never recovered, when there were "NO" children in the home at that time? The children were in school at the time.
3. Question: What difference does it make how many times you call about your ex-spouse's abuse of your child, to be criticized for making another complaint to protect your child from abuse or neglect.
4. Question: Why was I almost arrested for trying to protect my son from his abusive mother, one weekend when I had my son for court ordered visitation? Why is it police say they can't intervene when there is interference of a father's non-custodial parents rights, yet when a mother complains about custodial interference by the father everyone including DCF is ready and willing to criminalize that father? Why did the Judge who heard my ex-wife's contempt of court complaint, threaten me with incarceration, when if I ever try and protect my son again from his abusive mother. I testified under oath, that my only motivation for not returning my son after my weekend visit, was to protect him from his abusing mother because she had started beating him again. He was about five years old at the time.
5. Question: Why are hot line persons, assuming, sarcastic and critical of fathers when we complain about our ex-spouses ?
6. Question: Why does DCF keep a record of how many complaints on makes and make it known to the caller how many times you have called?
Is it legal for DCF to ask a complainant if he or she has a disability ?
