Attention: Members of the Labor Committee

I am Gary Peck the CFO/ Owner of North American Theatrix located in Waterbury, Connecticut.

I am writing to voice my **opposition** to HB-6187. Our employees already reap the benefits of 50% of their health benefits being paid, paid vacations and bonuses. If it is made mandatory that each employee receive another 52 hours of paid time off per year sick time as you call it, without any recourse in making this time up then we will be forced to reevaluate our whole system package, possibly cutting staff and the benefits of employees that on the most part have been with the company for years.

At the present time we are building a new 15,000 sq/ft facility in Southington, CT and have in the future plans to hire as many as seven new employees over the next three years. If this law becomes real I am positive our guidelines for hiring and advancement will drastically change.

I urge the committee to reject this proposal especially in these economic times which are the worse most of us have ever experienced. Please don't make North American Theatrix add to the unemployment line.
