**"AN ACT CONCERNING INTERRUPTION OF
TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE, SCRAP METAL
PROCESSORS AND MOTOR VEHICLE RECYCLERS."**

- 1 In line 14, after "other" insert "scrap utility"
- 2 Strike section 2 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:
- 3 "Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of section 21-11a of the general statutes is
- 4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
- 5 *October 1, 2009*):
- 6 (a) A scrap metal processor, as defined in section 14-67w, shall
- 7 record, for all loads of scrap metal purchased or received by such
- 8 processor, a description of such scrap metal, the weight of such metal,
- 9 the price paid for such metal and the identification of the person who
- 10 delivered such metal. Such scrap metal processor shall take a
- 11 photograph of the motor vehicle delivering such scrap metal,
- 12 including the license plate of such vehicle. Such scrap metal processor
- 13 shall not be required to segregate scrap metal it receives from other

14 materials on its premises and hold the same for five days except for
15 wire, cable or other scrap utility equipment that could be used in the
16 transmission of telecommunications or data or the transmission or
17 distribution of electricity by an electric distribution company unless
18 purchased from (1) a person registered pursuant to section 29-402 to
19 engage in the business of demolition of buildings, or (2) a person who
20 has already segregated such scrap metal pursuant to this chapter and
21 such person provides such scrap metal processor with a written
22 statement affirming such segregation. Upon receipt of a load of scrap
23 metal which contains wire, cable or other scrap utility equipment that
24 could be used in the transmission of telecommunications or data or the
25 transmission or distribution of electricity by an electric distribution
26 company, such scrap metal processor shall take a photograph of the
27 motor vehicle delivering such scrap metal, including the license plate
28 of such vehicle, and of such load of scrap metal containing such
29 [that could be used in the transmission of telecommunications or data]
30 cable or other scrap utility equipment. Upon receipt of wire, cable or
31 other scrap utility equipment that could be used in the transmission of
32 telecommunications or data or the transmission or distribution of
33 electricity by an electric distribution company, such scrap metal
34 processor shall make a copy of the certificate of registration of such
35 vehicle, [;] record a description of the material received, [;] and record
36 a statement as to the location from which the material came."
