1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding any provision of  
4 the general statutes, no bill or amendment before the General  
5 Assembly creating or enlarging a state mandate, as defined in  
6 subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of section 2-32b of the general statutes,  
7 to local governments, as defined in subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of  
8 said section 2-32b, shall be considered passed or agreed to except upon  
9 the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members present in  
10 each chamber."
