**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PENALTY FOR POSSESSION OF A
SMALL AMOUNT OF MARIJUANA."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 14-111e of the general statutes is amended by
4 adding subsection (c) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2009*):

5 (NEW) (c) (1) The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall suspend
6 the motor vehicle operator's license or nonresident operating privilege
7 of any person under eighteen years of age who is convicted of a
8 violation of subsection (c) of section 21a-279, as amended by this act,
9 for a period of thirty days.

10 (2) The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall not issue a new
11 operator's license under section 14-36 to any person under eighteen
12 years of age who has not been issued a motor vehicle operator's license
13 under said section and who has been convicted of a violation of
14 subsection (c) of section 21a-279, as amended by this act, until a period

15 of one hundred fifty days has elapsed from the date all applicable
16 requirements for such license have been satisfied by the applicant."
