 - 5 In line 26, strike "(57)" and insert "(56)" in lieu thereof

 - 7 After line 30, insert the following:
 - 8 "(NEW) (57) The Governor shall proclaim March first of each year to
 - 9 be Self Injury Awareness Day to increase awareness of the issues
 - 10 surrounding self injury. Suitable exercises shall be held in the State

11 Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for the observance
12 of the day.

13 (NEW) (58) The Governor shall proclaim the third week in
14 September of each year to be Mitochondrial Disease Awareness Week
15 to raise awareness of Mitochondrial Disease. Suitable exercises shall be
16 held in the State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for
17 the observance of the week."

18 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
19 internal references accordingly:

20 "Sec. 501. Subdivision (23) of subsection (a) of section 10-29a of the
21 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
22 thereof (*Effective from passage*):

23 (23) The Governor shall proclaim September eleventh of each year
24 as Honor Our Heroes and Remembrance Day, in memory of those who
25 lost their lives or suffered injuries in the terrorist attacks on September
26 11, 2001, and in honor of the service, sacrifice and contributions of the
27 firefighters, police officers and other personnel who responded to such
28 attacks. Suitable exercises shall be held in the State Capitol and
29 elsewhere as the Governor designates for the observance of the day."
