**"AN ACT CONCERNING LONGITUDINAL STUDIES OF STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT."**

1 Strike lines 38 to 48, inclusive, and insert the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3 "(e) On and after August 1, 2009, upon receipt of a written request to  
4 access data maintained under this section, by (1) an institution of  
5 higher education, or (2) a nonprofit organization that is exempt from  
6 taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986,  
7 or any subsequent corresponding internal revenue code of the United  
8 States, as from time to time amended, and that is organized and  
9 operated for educational purposes, the Department of Education shall  
10 provide such data to such requesting party not later than sixty days  
11 after such request, provided such requesting party shall be responsible  
12 for the reasonable cost of such request. The Department of Information  
13 Technology shall monitor the calculation of such fees charged for  
14 access to or copies of such records to ensure that such fees are  
15 reasonable and consistent with those charged by other state agencies.

17 this section in the order in which they are received."
